

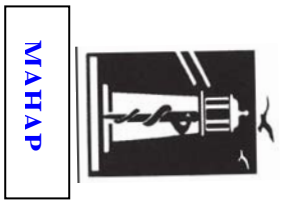

# Directions to TAMC

From 195 North turn RIGHT at Exit 305 to Houlton. At the foot of the hill, turn LEFT on US-1 north. Continue to follow US-1 for 27 miles to Mars Hill, bearing LEFT on US-1 and continue following for 14 miles. \***Presque Isle Inn & Convention Center** will be on your right, further down the hill -The University of Maine Presque Isle will be on your left, continue through to the second set of lights on Main Street. At the second light, turn RIGHT onto Academy Street and follow to the top of the hill (.84 miles). On your RIGHT you will see a sign for **TAMC**. Take this driveway and continue around to the back of the hospital to the Maple Parking area. You will enter at the Pinkham Entrance. The hallway to the conference rooms is to your left, just past the Patient Registration desk. The McCain Rooms will be facing you at the end of the hallway.
